

Win a free one-year patron account to Thad's M.I.L.L by subscribing to the Thaddeus Lake Music Foundation Newsletter.

The contest runs from June 17, 2023 to August 16, 2023 at 11:59PM MDT. Anyone subscribed to the Thaddeus Lake Music Foundation Newsletter within this time will be automatically entered to win a one-year free patron account to Thad's Musical Instrument Lending Library (Thad's M.I.L.L). The contest is independently run by the Thad's M.I.L.L and the Thaddeus Lake Music Foundation, a nonprofit and registered society in Alberta. This contest is not endorsed or sponsored by MailChimp, the Leduc Arts Foundry, the Leduc Recreation Centre, or the City of Leduc.

Eligibility Requirements

This contest is only open to subscribers of the Thaddeus Lake Music Foundation Newsletter (link) living within the boundaries of Leduc County (this includes all communities located within Leduc County). The winner must be 18 or older. The winner cannot be a Thaddeus Lake Music Foundation board member. The winner cannot be a family member of a Thaddeus Lake Music Foundation board member. The winner cannot be living in domicile (related or unrelated) to a Thaddeus Lake Music Foundation board member.

Winner Selection & Verification

On August 17, 2023 at approximately 12:00PM MDT time a winner will be randomly selected from our newsletter subscribers by Alouise Dittrick, the Executive Director of the Thaddeus Lake Music Foundation. The winner will then have 48 hours from the time of the email to respond to the email to potentially claim their prize. The winner must be willing to provide their first and last name, email address, phone number, and answer a skill-testing question. No other information will be required. To claim the prize the winner will also need to provide proof of residency within Leduc County when they go to redeem the gift certificate at Thad's M.I.L.L. See The Prize section for more details.

Should the selected winner not respond within the 48 hour time frame another winner will be selected. They will also have 48 hours from the time the winning email is sent to respond and will be subjected to the same winner selection conditions above. If this potential secondary person does not respond within 48 hours there will be no other prize winners selected and the prize will be forfeited.

The selected winner will only receive an email from Alouise Dittrick Executive Director of the Thaddeus Lake Music Foundation from the email address thadsfoundation17@gmail.com. Emails claiming a winner from any other email address and/or person are fraudulent and will not count as a winning email to claim the prize as listed in the rules. This includes messages or comments via Facebook or Instagram; these will also be considered fraudulent/scams and should not be answered. Any scam accounts should immediately be reported to their respective social media site (Facebook or Instagram) and blocked.

The Prize

The Prize is a one-year individual patron account to the Thad's Musical Instrument Lending Library (Thad's M.I.L.L) opening summer 2023. The prize will come in the form of a gift certificate signed by our board Chair Karen Lake and Executive Director Alouise Dittrick. The prize will only be valid for the chosen winner whose first and last name, email address, and phone number will be provided

during winner selection and verification. The prize cannot be duplicated, transferred, sold, and has no cash value. If the prize is lost, damaged, copied, or altered in any way the prize is forfeited and will not be reissued.

The prize (as originally issued) will need to be brought to Thad's M.I.L.L. located inside the Leduc Arts Foundry space at the Leduc Recreation Centre (4330 Black Gold Drive, Leduc) during regular Leduc Arts Foundry hours (see here for regular hours) by Friday September 29, 2023. Failure to come in to redeem the gift certificate before this date will result in a forfeit of the prize and no reissue of the prize will be given.

The prize winner will need to fill out and sign the Thad's Musical Instrument Lending Library (Thad's M.I.L.L.) 16+ Individual Patron Account - Registration Form. They will also need to read and abide by the Thad's Musical Instrument Lending Library (Thad's M.I.L.L.) Patron Account Terms and Conditions. Use of the prize means the winner is subjected to the account terms and conditions of Thad's M.I.L.L. If any of the terms and conditions of the Thad's M.I.L.L. account are breached at any time during the free one-year patron account term the account will be cancelled and the prize

Once activated the patron account will be valid for one-year from issue unless the account terms and conditions are breached or not met, at that point the account will immediately be cancelled and not be reissued. After the one-year membership is up the patron account will be cancelled unless the account holder decides to pay for another year of membership.

Other Terms

The winner understands their first name and last initial may be shared on the Thaddeus Lake Music Foundation website (thadsfoundation.com) and its affiliated social media pages (facebook.com/thadsfoundation and instagram.com/thadsfoundation) and in the September issue of the Thaddeus Lake Music Foundation Newsletter. The winner's full first and last name, along with their home address and contact information will need to be shared with Thad's M.I.L.L. staff/volunteers for the verification of the Thad's M.I.L.L. account during the registration process. As Thad's M.I.L.L. is located inside the Leduc Arts Foundry this may include Leduc Arts Foundry staff/volunteers as well. Failure to provide the correct contact information during registration for the free one-year Thad's M.I.L.L. account will result in a forfeit of the prize.
